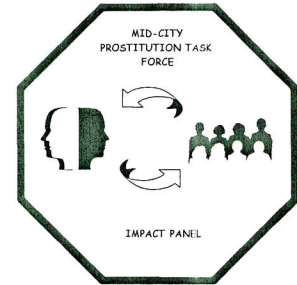




## PROSTITUTION IMPACT PANEL INFORMATION

**The Prostitution Impact Panel provides education and information to offenders about the far-reaching impact of prostitution activity on San Diego communities.**

Panel sessions are held on the first floor of 5348 University Avenue (the San Diego Police Department's Multi-Cultural Community Relations Office). The facility has free parking and is located close to bus lines. There is a **\$200 fee** to attend this program. You must bring this \$200 fee in the form of a **cashier's check or money order, payable to the San Diego City Treasurer.**

The panel lasts approximately three hours. Check-in begins at 5:30 p.m., and the panel begins promptly at 6:00 p.m. No attendee will be allowed into the session once it begins. The session should end no later than 9:00 p.m. You must pay the \$200 fee and attend the entire panel in order to receive your certificate of completion.

**ONCE YOU CHOOSE THE DATE OF THE PANEL SESSION YOU PLAN TO ATTEND, YOU MUST ATTEND THAT SESSION.**
